This Invitation for Tenders follows the General Procurement Notice № 7933-GPN-44243 for this project which was published on the EBRD website, Procurement Notices (www.ebrd.com) on June 15, 2015.

Osh City Municipal Auto-transport Enterprise hereinafter referred to as “the Employer”, intends to use part of the proceeds of a loan and grant from the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (the Bank) towards the cost of Osh Public Transport Project.

The Employer now invites sealed tenders from contractors for the following contract to be funded from part of the proceeds of the loan and grant:

Package №: OGMAP 003/2016 Phase # 2 – Rehabilitation of power supply infrastructure cabling, installation and civil works – 26 weeks

Tendering for contracts to be financed with the proceeds of a loan and grant from the Bank is open to firms from any country.

To be qualified for the award of a contract, tenderers must satisfy the following minimum criteria:

the tenderer has the financial, technical and production capability and capacity necessary to perform the Contract and must have at least Euro 1 000 000 annual turnover in average for last 5 years, as well as must have the profitable result of economic activity in each of last 5 years and shall demonstrate that it has access to, or has available, liquid assets, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit, and other financial means sufficient to meet the production cash flow for the contract estimated as not less than Euro 250 000 of the planned contract price;

The Tenderer shall demonstrate that it has successful experience as prime contractor in the execution of at least five projects of a nature and complexity comparable to the proposed contract within the last 5 years that have been successfully and substantially completed. The Tenderer or its specialised sub-contractor shall have a license for conducting of electrical cabling works up to 10 KV (as required by the Kyrgyz legislation);

the tenderer will be able to carry out the supplier’s maintenance, repair obligations prescribed in these tender documents.

the tenderer shall provide accurate information on any current or past litigation or arbitration resulting from contracts complement or under execution by him over the last 5 (five) years. A consistent history of awards against the tenderer or any partner of a joint venture or consortia may result in rejection of the tenderer’s tender.

The Tenderer shall provide suitably qualified personnel to fill the following positions. For each position the Tenderer will supply information (in table 2.5) on a first choice candidate and an alternate, each of whom should meet the experience requirements specified below:

Position – Total Work Similar Experience (years) – In Similar Works Experience (years)

Project Manager (1) – 20 – 10

Site Manager (1) – 10 – 5

Site Civil Engineer (1) – 10 – 5

Site Electrical Engineer (1) -10-5

Geodetic Surveyor (1) – 5 – 3

The tenderer shall own, or have assured access to (through hire, lease, purchase agreement, availability of manufacturing equipment, or other means), the following key items of equipment in full working order, and must demonstrate that, based on known commitments, they will be available for use in the proposed contract. The Tenderer may also list alternative equipment which he would propose to use for the contract, together with an explanation of the proposal:

Dump Truck with capacity 12 tn – 1

Excavator 0,25 m³ – 1

Concrete mixing station with capacity 16m³ /h – 1

Front loader with capacity 2 m³ – 1

Joint ventures or consortia shall satisfy the following minimum qualification criteria:

The firm - leader of the consortium shall correspond to at least 50% of all the above referred qualification criteria on general experience and financial status.

The rest members of the consortium shall correspond to at least 25% of all the above referred qualification criteria on general experience and financial status.

Joint venture or consortium shall meet in whole criteria for delivery experience and production capacity, licensing, as well as the financial status referred to above, the corresponding data, that defines the overall capacity of the joint venture or consortium, shall be specified for each consortium member. Each consortium member shall meet the requirements for eligibility and trials.

Contracts to be financed with the proceeds of the loan and grant from the Bank will be subject to the Bank's Procurement Policies and Rules and will be open to firms from any country of origin. The proceeds of the Bank's loan will not be used for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations or under a law of official regulation of the Purchaser's country.
