Supply of equipment for rehabilitation of Osh city trolleybus electrical infrastructure, including incidental services

This Invitation for Tenders follows the General Procurement Notice № 7933-GPN-44243 for this project which was published on the EBRD website, Procurement Notices (www.ebrd.com) on June 15, 2015.

Osh City Municipal Auto-transport Enterprise hereinafter referred to as “the Purchaser”, intends to use part of the proceeds of a loan and grant from the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (the Bank) towards the cost of Osh Public Transport Project.

The Purchaser now invites sealed tenders from Suppliers for the following contracts to be funded from part of the proceeds of the loan and grant:

Package №: OGMAP 003/2016 Lot # 1 – Supply of contact wire for power supply 16 km, carrying cables 20 km, special parts, including incidental services, DAP (Osh), 26 weeks

Package №: OGMAP 003/2016 Lot # 2 – Supply of traction equipment for the substations 21 units, protection devices for feeder cells automatic equipment 17 units, including incidental services, DAP (Osh), 26 weeks

Package №: OGMAP 003/2016 Lot # 3 – Supply Hi-up truck for contact-cable system servicing 1 unit, including incidental services, DAP (Osh), 26 weeks

All contracts are to be implemented concurrently.

Tenders are invited for one or more lots. Each lot must be priced separately and contract awarded to the tenderer offers the lowest evaluated price for each lot separately.

Tendering for contracts that are to be financed with the proceeds of a loan and grant from the Bank is open to firms from any country.

To be qualified for the award of a contract, tenderers must satisfy the following minimum criteria:

in the case of a tenderer offering to supply goods under the Contract which the tenderer does not manufacture or otherwise produce, the tenderer has been duly authorised by the goods’ manufacturer or producer to supply the goods in the Purchaser’s country;

the tenderer has the financial, technical and production capability and capacity necessary to perform the Contracts and must have at least: Lot # 1 – Euro 500,000, Lot # 2 – Euro 1,800,000, Lot # 3 – Euro 200,000 annual turnover in average for last 5 years, as well as must have the profitable result of economic activity in each of last 5 years and shall demonstrate that it has access to, or has available, liquid assets, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit, and other financial means sufficient to meet the production cash flow for the contract estimated as not less than Lot # 1 – Euro 120,000, Lot # 2 – Euro 400,000, Lot # 3 – Euro 60,000 Euro of the planned contract price;

Experience as Supplier, in at least 3 contracts within the last 5 years that have been successfully and substantially completed and that are similar to the proposed Goods. The similarity shall be based on the

physical size, complexity, methods/technology or other characteristics as described in Section VI, Supply Requirements.

the tenderer or its agent will be able to carry out the supplier's maintenance, repair and spare parts stocking obligations prescribed in these tender documents.

the proposed models must be contemporary and be produced in series. Good's manufacturer must have a certificate of quality management system (ISO 9000, or its equivalent).

the tenderer shall provide accurate information on any current or past litigation or arbitration resulting from contracts complement or under execution by him over the last 5 (five) years. A consistent history of awards against the tenderer or any partner of a joint venture or consortia may result in rejection of the tenderer's tender.

Joint ventures or consortia shall satisfy the following minimum qualification criteria:

The firm - leader of the consortium shall correspond to at least 50% of all the above referred qualification criteria on general experience and financial status.

The rest members of the consortium shall correspond to at least 25% of all the above referred qualification criteria on general experience and financial status.

Joint venture or consortium shall meet in whole criteria for delivery experience and production capacity, as well as the financial status referred to above, the corresponding data, that defines the overall capacity of the joint venture or consortium, shall be specified for each consortium member. Each consortium member shall meet the requirements for eligibility and trials.

Contracts to be financed with the proceeds of the loan and the grant from the Bank will be subject to the Bank's Procurement Policies and Rules and will be open to firms from any country and origin. The proceeds of the Bank's loan and grant will not be used for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations or under a law of official regulation of the Purchaser's country.
