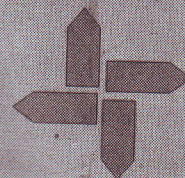

INVITATION FOR SUBMISSION OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

CONSULTING SERVICES FOR PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION INCLUDING CONSTRUCTION
SUPERVISION, CONTRACT MANAGEMENT, AND OTHER IMPLEMENTATION ACTIVITIES
IN NORTHERN PROVINCE (PIC 04)

1. The Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka has applied a multitranche financing facility (MFF) for the Integrated Road Investment Program (iRoad) from the Asian Development Bank (ADB). The MFF will comprise a series of loans to improve the access routes between rural areas and socioeconomic centers in tranches. Part of the funds from the MFF shall be used to engage an International Consultancy Firm as Project Implementation Consultant (PIC) to assist Road Development Authority (RDA) which is the Implementing Agency (IA) in project implementation including construction supervision, contract management, and other implementation activities in Northern Province.
2. The assignment includes
 - Reviewing and confirming the design and scope of works of conventional road contract packages.
 - Construction supervision of Conventional Road Contract packages
 - Providing on-the-job training to the Project Implementation Unit (PIU), Executing Agency (EA) and IA in project management and contract administration.
 - More details are given in Outlined Terms of Reference.
3. The consulting services will be carried out by a team of international and national consultants. A total of 36 person-months of international consultant inputs and 2,916 person months of national (Key and Non-key) will be required in a period of 60 months (actual duration of service shall be in line with the schedule of civil works). All experts, international or national, must be proficient in both written and spoken English.
4. Now eligible consulting firms are invited to indicate their interest in providing the required services. Interested consultants must prepare and submit an "Expression of Interest (EOI)" in standard form, "Template for Expression of Interest (Consulting Firms)", which can be obtained by contacting the EA or downloading from the ADB website (<https://www.adb.org/site/business-opportunities/operational-procurement/consulting/documents#loansandclick> "Firms"). The EOI may be submitted either online through ADB's website or in hardcopy to the address indicated below.
5. A short list will be prepared based on the evaluation of the EOI. The final selection of the consultancy firm to undertake the assignments will be made from the short list after inviting detailed Requests for Proposals (RFPs). The consulting firm will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the ADB Guidelines on the Use of Consultants by the Asian Development Bank and Its Borrowers using Quality – and Cost –Based Selection (QCBS) procedure.

All requested information must be filled in completely. For hard copy submission: (1) obtain the "Template for Expression of Interest (Consulting Firms)" as instructed above, and (2) prepare and submit to the address indicated below in an envelope clearly titled – "Expression of Interest for Project Implementation including Construction Supervision, Contract Management, and other implementation activities in Northern Province".
7. EOI must be submitted online or received to the address indicated below before 12 May 2017.
