Hotels

The EUREM 2017 will be held at the Ljubljana Exhibition and Convention Centre situated in the very centre of Ljubljana. The main railway and bus stations are in the walking distance from the conference venue. The Jože Pučnik Ljubljana international airport is located at 25 km from the city centre and can be reached within a 20-minute ride.

Ljubljana provides a good range of accommodation facilities of all categories and types, currently totalling to around 2,550 hotel rooms. Majority of accommodation alternatives are in the close vicinity of the Ljubljana Exhibition and Convention Centre.
