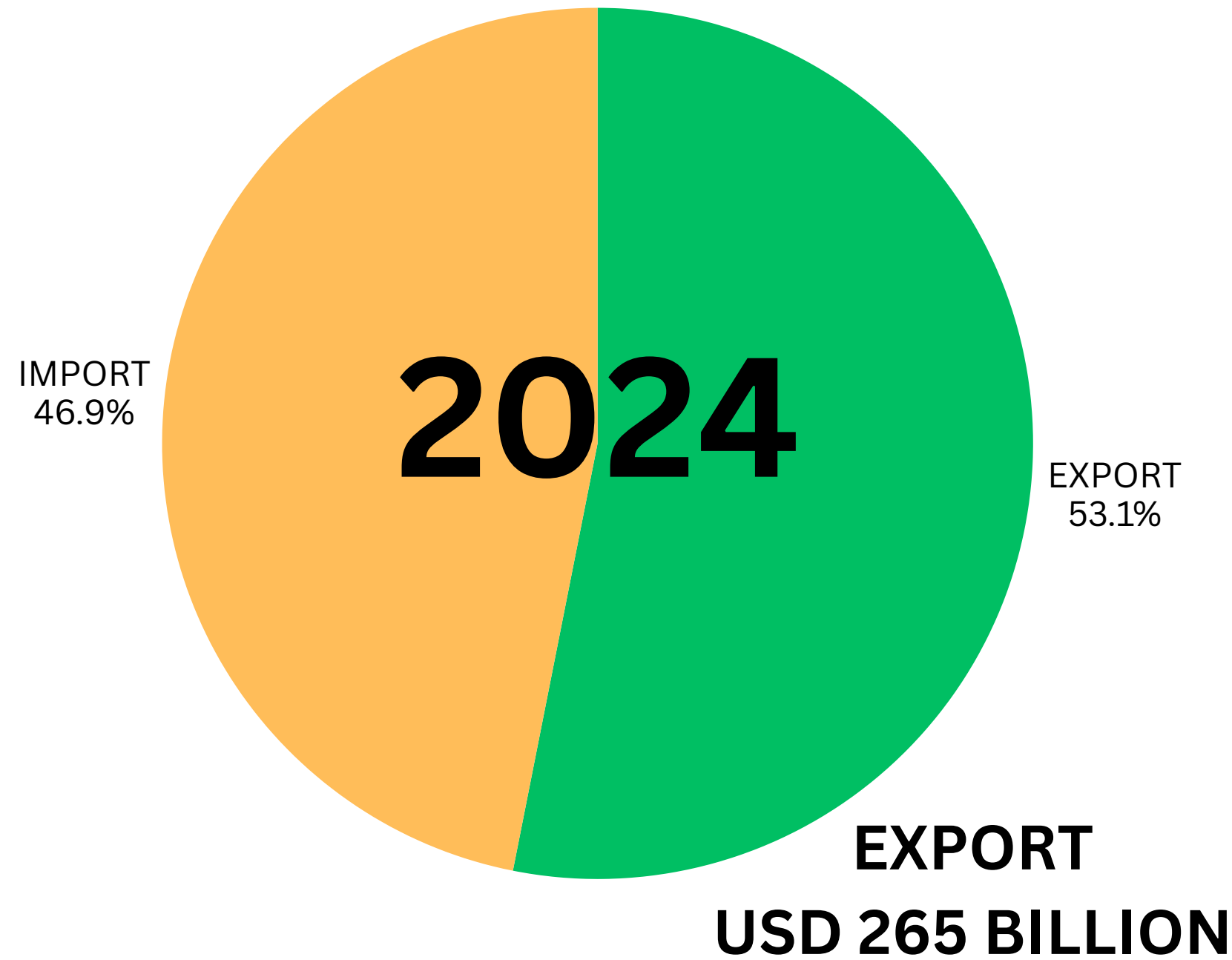

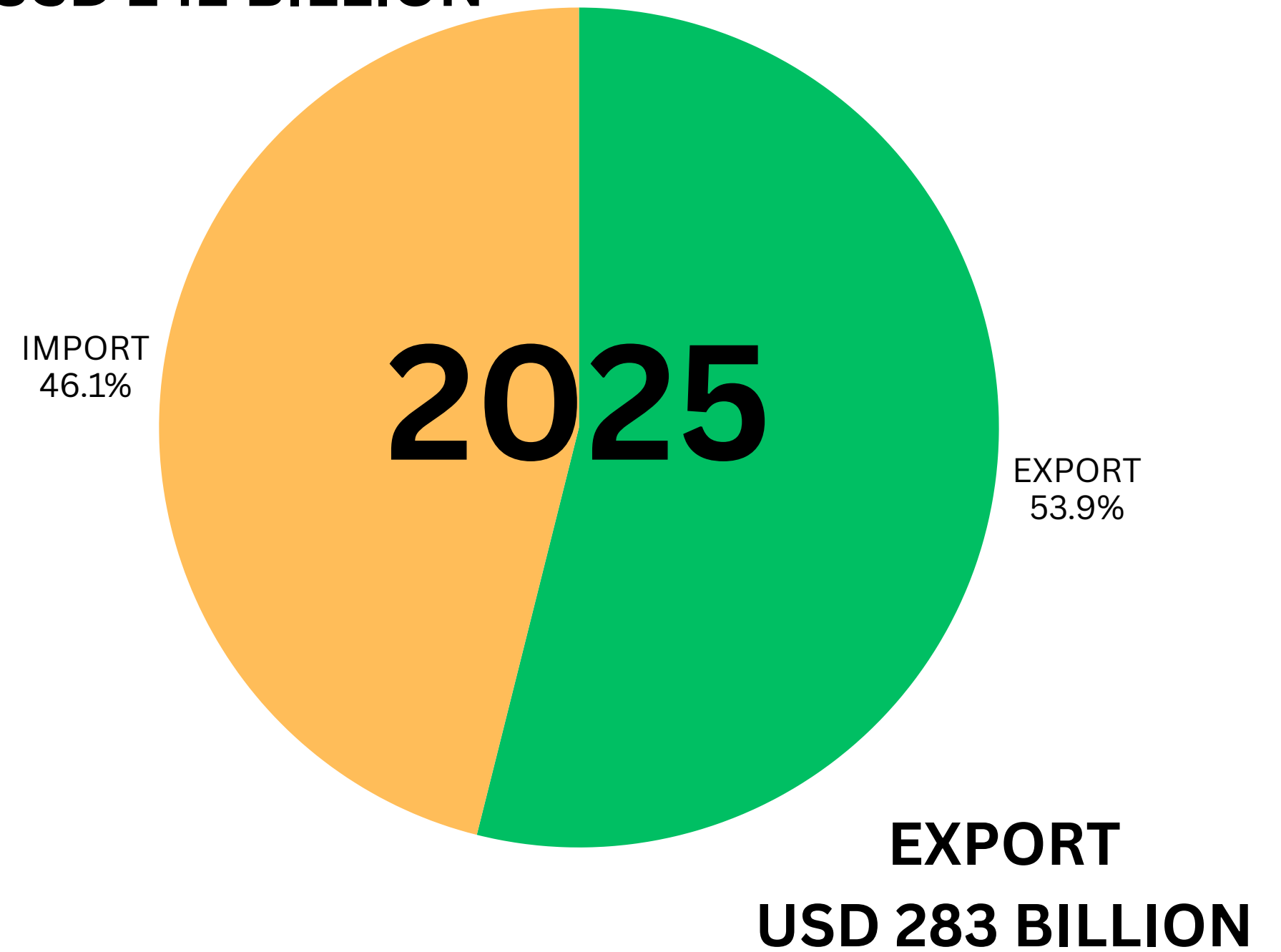
- Romania recognized Republic of Indonesia as an Independent State on 18 February 1950

What's The Matter?

Deal signed to boost Indonesia-EU trade



Indonesia-European Union Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (IEU-CEPA) has been signed on 23rd September 2025, which is expected to boost Indonesia's export value to the EU by 2.5x.

In the CEPA agreement, **80% of the products** between ID-EU will be **tariff-free** immediately, and up to **96% of total trade** in the next five years. This covers **98% of all categories**, and nearly all trade by value.



Expand Market Access

Indonesia-EU trade focus

Under this agreement, Indonesia will remove high duties on industrial products, such as:



Motor vehicles

Current tariffs up to 50%, will be removed over 5 years



Machinery and electrical equipment

Mostly duty-free at start, remaining after 5 years



Pharmaceuticals

Mostly duty-free at start, remaining after 3 years



Chemicals

Mostly duty-free at start, remaining after five years

Meanwhile EU will remove high duties on agri-food exports, such as:



Processed foods

Current up to 30% tariffs, most removed immediately, few phased



Most dairy products

Current up to 10% tariffs, to be eliminated mostly at entry into force



Meat products

Current 5 to 20% tariffs, to be eliminated mostly at entry into force

Daya Anagata Nusantara (Danantara) is a sovereign fund that oversees the assets of the Indonesian Government, including State-Owned Enterprise (SOE)



Danantara was established through the enactment of Law Number 19 of 2003 on BUMN on Tuesday, February 4, 2025.

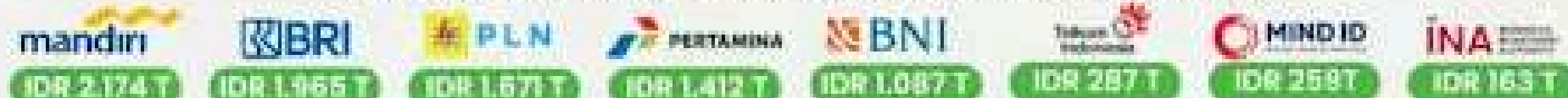


Act as a superholding to oversee BUMNs and an investment firm to manage dividends and optimize asset leverage.



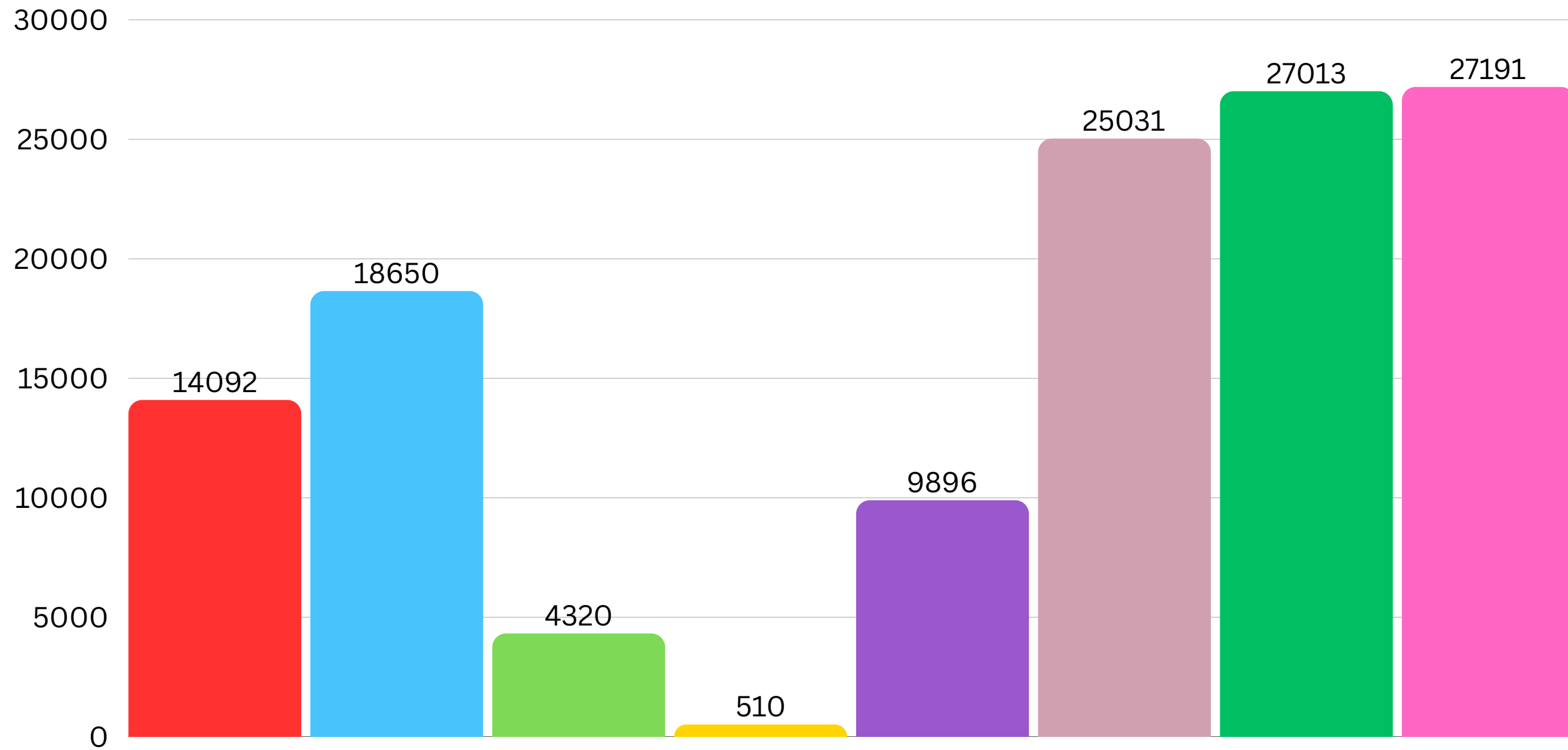
Danantara is poised to obtain an initial capital injection of IDR 1,000 trillion (\$83.2 billion)

Danantara will consolidate the Indonesia Investment Authority (INA) and seven Indonesian BUMNs, with other state-owned companies gradually coming under its management:

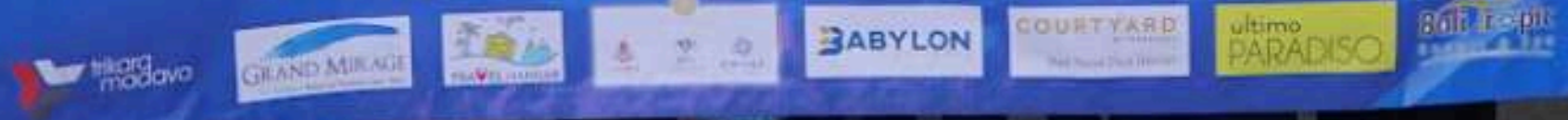

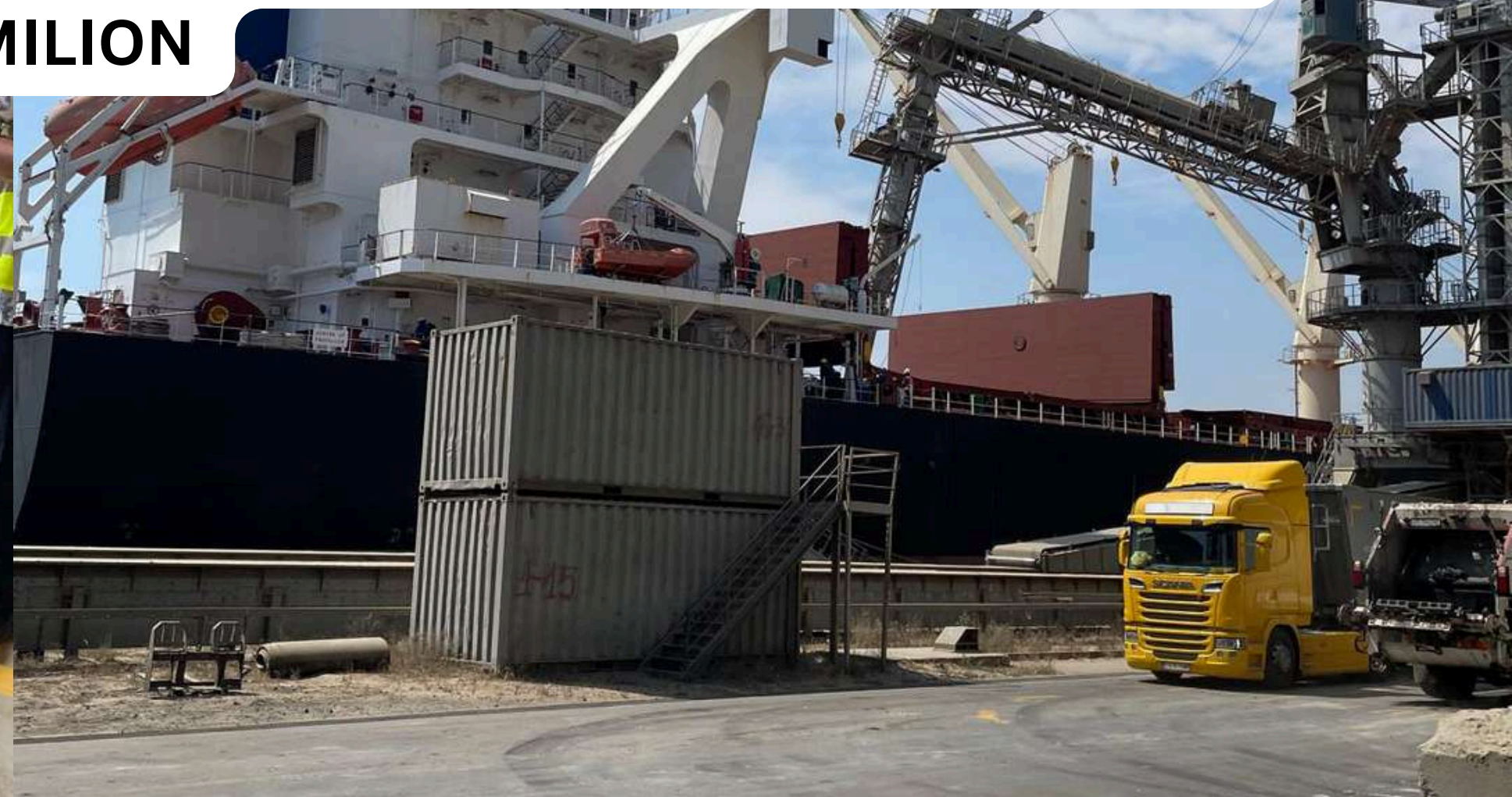
